The estate is located in the village of Tizac de Curton, in the Gironde department in Nouvelle-Aquitaine in southwestern France. There are 62 acres of vineyards on rocky slopes and plateau. The soil is Clayey-calcareous. Traditional vinification in stainless steel vats with traditional cold maceration. Aging in cement vats. Maceration after fermentation under pomace. Daily pumping-over.

The estate has belonged to the Ferrand family since 1930. The grandson Christian Ferrand, took over the estate in his name in 1991.
