



CHÂTEAU CHICANE GRAVES ROUGE

Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Deep and brilliant garnet color. Intense aromas of raspberries and blueberries with smoky notes and undergrowth. The palate is round with an elegant structure and a silky finish. Serve slightly chilled. This wine perfectly accompanies grilled meat or meat sauce.

Bordering the south of the Valley of the Garonne on its left bank, Château Chicane continually has excellent sunshine and gives the wine a faithful expression of the terroir of the Graves dunes. The vineyard, located in Toulence, covers 15 acres. The soil is argilo-calcaire. The average vine age is 35-40 years.

This vineyard in the Bordeaux region, created in 1875 by the Coste family, has been in the family of François Gauthier, the current owner for the last 130 years.
