

LA REINE DE LA VILLE PINOT NOIR, ÎLE DE BEAUTÉ

100% Pinot Noir. Medium bodied and dry with bright fresh fruits that mingle with hints of licorice, mineral and a hint of spice notes. The wine's sunny origin is clear from its fruity profile, but this is balanced out nicely by earthy elements, bright acidity and moderate tannin. Try paired with salmon, poultry and soft, light cheeses. Great with pizza and light pastas.

Reine de La Ville Pinot Noir comes from the incredible Mediterranean island of Corsica, France. It is produced under the "Ile de Beaute" IGP which translates into "The Isle of Beauty" (a traditional French synonym for Corsica.) Granite, shale and limestone make up the majority of the soils. Traditional vinification under controlled temperatures to allow for a good color extraction and retention of fresh aromas and fruit flavor. Three to six month aging in stainless steel.
