DR. HERMANN WINES ERDENER HERZLEI RIESLING SPÄTLESE

100% Riesling; vine age 100 to over 120 years old. Light golden yellow color. Aromas of herbs, spices and stone fruits. Clear, with a creamy texture. Concentrated, with flavors of dried apricot. Fine acidity well balanced with minerals expressing notes of slate. Long, spicy finish.

The soil is blue slate, from a special selection of the best parts of the *Herzlei* (heart shaped) vineyard, which is extremely steep and faces Southeast. The vines are 100 to more than 120 years old. Irrigation not used in the vineyards. The grapes are hand harvested at optimum ripeness, followed by a strict selection of the best berries. The wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks. Kept on the lees for 4 months.

Founded over 400 years ago in Mosel, Germany. Dr. Hermann Winery, the Riesling-Estate, is 16 acres and managed by the father and son team of Rudi and Christian Hermann. Their philosophy is that quality starts in the vineyard with restrained pruning, hand harvesting, natural and careful cultivation of vineyard soil. The result is beautiful, elegant wine from some of the most famous vineyard sites in the world. The Hermanns specialize in Riesling grown on steep rock slopes of the famous vineyards of the Erdener Prälat, Erdener Treppchen, and the Ürziger Würzgarten. All of their vineyards grow exclusively on old vines—ungrafted Riesling vines, which deliver beautiful, complex Riesling wines.
