

# GUIDOBONO SEGRETE VIGNE EXTRA BRUT



100% Nebbiolo. The name of this wine means secret vines; the wine laws in Italy do not allow for the name of the varietal to appear on the label for sparkling wines vinified in the classic champagne method. Fine Mousse. Aromas of yeast. Flavors of yellow apple cider with flowers, yeast and minerals. Strong acidity. Bone dry, but rich and zesty. Long finish. A beautiful aperitif. Try paired with spicy Asian dishes. Early harvest, 36 months on the yeasts, zero dosage. Fermented and matured in bottle for 30 months.

Guidobono is the creation of the Faccenda family and reflects their obsession with terroir. They make a range of wines from the Roero and Langhe hills, all of them outstanding value. Their vineyards are scattered through the area. The vineyards of the Roero are their family's home, where they both live and work. In keeping with their respect for nature, they use the "integrated farming" agricultural practices set up by the EU and their winery is also a proud participant in Piemonte's "Vino Sicuro" project, aimed at keeping their region's wines free of harmful pollutants.
