

CHÂTEAU HAUTES VERSANNES SAINT-EMILION

Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Aromas of cherries, plums, earth, spices and tobacco. Flavors of fresh dark and red fruits, mineral salinity and elegant tannins. Great texture and balance. Savory, rich and long. Serve at room temperature. It is the perfect match for hearty casseroles, roast or grilled red meats and rich cheeses.

The vineyards of Château Hautes Versannes are located in the village of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens, in the Saint Emilion Appelation of the Bordeax winemaking region. The estate vineyard covers 26 acres in all. The soil is sandy and clayey with limestone. The average age of the vines is 35 years. Fermented in stainless steel after a preferment maceration of one week. Pressed vertically for a very soft extraction.

Aged in vats for 12-14 months.

Château Hautes Versannes is a lovely small estate owned by the Lacoste family.
