SENTIER COTEAUX D'AIX-EN-PROVENCE ROSÉ

Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah and Counoise. Notes of raspberry, strawberries and tropical fruit. Crisp, dry, bright and refreshing. Balanced acidity. Organic.

From vines planted 2004-2009 in the Badasset Vineyard, in the valley of Chateau-Bas, Coteaux d'ail en Provence, France. The soil is limestone substrate. 100% destemmed, rosé saignée with short maceration. Controlled alcoholic fermentation at low temperature. Malolactic fermentation unwanted. Elevage in tanks on the fine lees, during winter.

Sentier is a delicious, refreshing & organic Provençal rosé crafted in collaboration between Paris Wine Company & Château Bas. Located just northwest of Aix-en-Provence, Château Bas began farming organically in the early 1990s with the arrival of winemaker Philippe Pouchin & have spent decades working to create balance in the vineyard through biodiversity. The domaine was sold upon the retirement of Pouchin, and today, the wines are better than ever, thanks to the care of new winemaker Vincent Deturmeny, who is able to benefit from the vision of Philippe Pouchin as well as the new investments in the winery made by the new owner, Philippe Castéja.

The label is inspired from a vintage luggage sticker album which Paris Wine Company founder Joshua Adler discovered at an antique book and magazine dealer in Paris.
