

BEESLAAR TAJ



100% Pinotage. Deep ruby red color. Pronounced plum and dark chocolate aromas. The richness of the fruit flavors is balanced by a silky, dry finish.

The grapes for TAJ are sourced from the largest Pinotage vineyard in the world, which is located in the Swartland of South Africa, and is made up of 20-year-old, unirrigated bushvines, planted in soils of decomposed shale. These bushvines are able to weather the harsh conditions of the Swartland, and create smaller, more concentrated berries. Beeslaar wines are matured for 17 months in French oak, 50% new.

Abrie Beeslaar, winemaker at esteemed Stellenbosch property Kanonkop, now has his own label named Beeslaar. Jamie Goode explained the Beeslaar Pinotage as being *“one of the most profound interpretations of the often tricky Pinotage grape that you can imagine. It’s the Grand Cru Burgundy of Pinotages: structured, fresh, complex, ageworthy and elegant, despite its obvious concentration.”*
