100% Lacrima di Morro d'Alba. Light pink in color with ruby sparkles. Aromas of rose petals and cherries. Flavors of strawberry with a crisp, dry finish. Dreamy and fresh with fine and persistent perlage. Divine!

Conti di Buscareto has focused its efforts in part on the resurrection of a local red grape called "Lacrima Nera" or "Black Tears." Named for its loss of juice when the grape becomes very ripe, Lacrima Nera produces aromatic wines with notes of rose petals, and has recently been saved from extinction. Buscareto's "Spumanti" line is the result of the first harvest of grapes and is fresh and lively. A slow second fermentation gives the noble and velvety bubble a beautiful structure and a crisp freshness.

In 2002, Claudio Gabellini and Enrico Giacomelli, well-known IT entrepreneurs, decided to invest in the wine business by acquiring three valued vineyards in the most suitable areas of the Marche Region. They now have 5 farms in the hinterlands of Ancona and Senigallia. Of over 250 acres, 175 are under vine. The company was developed together with wine expert Vito Camussi and historical enologist Giancarlo Soverchia by building the winery and the wine philosophy.
