Sparkling Rosé of Pinot Noir. Watermelon pink. Lively, with vibrant acidity and a delightful gentle fizz. Fruity notes of bright peach, fleshy red apple and ripe strawberry spring forth. A pleasant cider-like fermentation funk deftly mingles with hints of lime and dried rose, leading to a refreshingly bone-dry finish. A joyful and delicate sparkler. Exciting by itself, or paired with smoked salmon or warm baked brie. Organic.
