

CHÂTEAU LALANDE SAINT JULIEN



Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Bright ruby color. Elegant aromas of crushed red & black berries, spices and a hint of vanilla. Rich and round in the mouth with a touch of freshness. Delicate and fruity. Soft, well integrated tannins and a long finish. Enjoy with steaks, barbecue and rich cheeses.

Château Lalande is located in the town of Saint-Julien-Beychevelle, along the road of great wines on the estuary of the Gironde, near the Talbot and Lagrange castles in the Bordeaux appellation of Saint-Julien, France. Its vineyard, of 15.5 hectares in one piece, located on a gravelly plateau. The average vine age is 30 years. Sustainable agricultural farming. After manual harvest and sorting, grapes undergo a cold soak for 48 hours to extract color and aromas, and are fermented at controlled temperatures in traditional cement and stainless-steel vats. Aged 12 months in French oak barrels, 35% new.

Chateau Lalande is a small family owned estate in Saint Julien, owned by the Meffre brothers. The history of Château Lalande is closely linked to that of Château Lagrange since the property was part of this estate since 1855, until being sold to its current owner, Gabriel Meffre, in 1964. Today it is managed Jean-Paul and his two sons, Ludovic and Julien.
