100% Barbera. Intense ruby red in color. Aromas of wild prune, black cherry jam and pepper. Dry but enveloping with sweet notes of red fruits. Balanced alcohol and stunningly soft thanks to its reduced acidity. Bava's Pianoalto estate in Crena hosts wonderful Barbera vineyards, gathered around the farmhouse on the Crena hill, overlooking the delightful village of Agliano and its thermal springs in the valley. The vineyards on the hilltop are flat. All wines produced in this farmhouse are prestigious and highly representative of the most classical area of Monferrato Astigiano, the village in the Nizza area. From young vines of Pianoalto di Crena. The vineyard is at 250m altitude with limestone soil. Fermentation occurs in steel vats. Aged in the bottle before release.

The Bava Family has grown grape vines in Cocconato, a village that rises steeply up the hillsides of the Monferrato Astigiano territory in Piedmont, Italy, since 1600. In 1911 the family built their first wine cellar there. Since then, over a hundred vintages have gone by, with six generations following one another. The best Bava Barberas are renowned in the world thanks to their high quality. Now the family estate extends over 123 acres of vineyards & 50 acres of natural fields & woods, cultivated with the same awareness, care & attention of the olden times; a sustainable agriculture with a reduced environmental impact.
