100% Nebbiolo. The color of the wine is a ruby red, lively & pleasant. Its bouquet reminds of flowers & fruits, like small red fruits or violets, but it has also a spicy note. On the palate, the taste is elegant, full-bodied & savory, characteristics due to its rounded tannins typical of Castiglione Falletto cru.

From Scarribe cru in Castiglione Falletto at 300 meters. The youngest vineyard in Bava's winery. The soil is white limestone and clay. Grapes are hand-picked in small baskets, then fermentation takes place in large wooden vats. Malolactic fermentation in stainless steel tanks. The wine is bottled in summer, where it continues to age until the next spring.

The Bava Family has grown grape vines in Cocconato, a village that rises steeply up the hillsides of the Monferrato Astigiano territory in Piedmont, Italy, since 1600. In 1911 the family built their first wine cellar there. Since then, over a hundred vintages have gone by, with six generations following one another. The best Bava Barberas are renowned in the world thanks to their high quality. Now the family estate extends over 123 acres of vineyards & 50 acres of natural fields & woods, cultivated with the same awareness, care & attention of the olden times; a sustainable agriculture with a reduced environmental impact.
