DOMAINE BREYTON CROZES-HERMITAGE

100% Syrah. Dark crimson color. Black cherry, leather, raspberry and chocolate. Complex and structured. Incredibly fresh, expressive and classic, making it one of the most unique and true versions of this wine in the appellation. Organic & Biodynamic.

Domaine Breyton is located in the town of Beaumont-Monteux, in the southern section of Crozes-Hermitage, Northern Rhône, France. The grapes come from the Beaumont-Monteux, Serves, and Gervans Estate vineyards, planted from 1946-50. The soil is made up of alluvial stones and granite. Following a manual harvest, the grapes are destemmed and fermented in stainless steel tanks with native yeasts. The wine then ages for nine months in stainless-steel.

Jacques Breyton has been working his 20 acres of vines & his fruit orchards organically & biodynamically since the 90s, as an ecosystem with biodiversity yields healthy & complex fruits. His meticulous, thoughtful farming & simple, restrained winemaking, is how he transmits terroir to the glass so transparently. Crozes-Hermitage is not the flashiest appellation in the Northern Rhône, but its down-toearth unpretentiousness suits Jacques Breyton well, as he prefers to quietly and methodically go about his business of crafting soulful wine, as well as growing apricots and other fruits on his biodynamic farm. (He has been bottling his own wine since 2005. Previously, he sold his yield to négociants and the local co-op, as he has always been a grower.) The wines of Domaine Breyton convey authenticity and sincerity often lacking in many modern wines bearing the Crozes-Hermitage label.
