

BELLINO PROSECCO ROSÉ DOC, VENETO

Glera and Pinot Noir. Softly dry with citrus and honeysuckle aromas, and lively effervescence. Fresh berry and pear flavors mingle with toasty notes in this sparkling rosé wine. Ideal as an aperitif. Pair with soft cheeses and appetizers, like bacon wrapped figs, fried foods and creamy pastas. Sourced from the Veneto and Friuli Venezia Giulia regions, production is carried out in small batches. The secondary fermentation period (Charmat Method) lasts 60 days in temperature-controlled stainless- steel. Bellino Prosecco is produced the Sperone family, a fifth-generation winemaking family whose roots began in Vermouth production. A century ago, as the family business grew, production expanded to include table wines. The Sperone family is dedicated to producing authentic Italian wines at affordable prices.
