

DOMAINE NUDANT LADOIX



100% Pinot Noir. Deep red color. The nose shows intense and varied aromas of red fruits and spices. On the palate notes of dark strawberries, cherry compote and pickled morello cherries as well as hints of spices, elderberry, leather and mocha. Elegant; good balance. Soft tannins and long-lasting finish. Pairs nicely with roasted meat, cold meat platters and the local cheese Citeaux.

The vineyard is in the Ladoix Appellation of Burgundy, France at 310m altitude with a very unique south-east orientation and covers 5.7 acres. Located at the northern door of the Côte de Beaune right beside from the Côte de Nuits. The vines are 40+ years-old. The soil is clay limestone.

Domaine Nudant has over 250 years of history, with 4 generations inspired by the same willingness and the same conviction, to always do well. Each generation applies itself with force and determination to work the vines which are a source of life, joy and hard work. As early as 1453, a man named Guillaume Nudant was producing wine. In 1747, his descendant Andre Nudant was born in Aloxe, and made his wines in Ladoix. Another descendant of the family, Andre Nudant, expanded the winery in 1950. His son Jean-René joined the business in 1978, followed 25 years later by his son Guillaume. Guillaume Nudant is now the 4th generation to follow his family's tradition of producing award-winning wines in the Côte de Beaune and Côte de Nu-its. The winery is located in the rolling countryside of Ladoix-Serrigny and Corton. From the very beginning, very strict rules were applied in the selection of the grapes. This method is still used today. The winery covers over 40 acres in the Côte de Beaune and the Côte de Nuits. It houses 20 appellations. This includes wines such as Village, 1er Cru and Grand Cru. It is with controlled yields, frequent ploughing and the use of chemical-free fertilizer that they respect their terroir and its distinctive characteristics. Convinced that there is a need for equilibrium between work, nature and terroir, the Domaine only treats the vineyards when necessary.
