The palate is vibrant and fresh showing off dark fruits and herbaceous varietal notes with silky tannins and a bright natural balance. Full bodied, highlights the fruit's vibrancy and structure.

Sourced from the Margaret River in Western Australia, Australia's pre-eminent Cabernet Sauvignon region. This variety has real affinity for the soils and maritime weather conditions. The vines are 25 years-old. The soil in the vineyard is red gravelly loam. The fruit was harvested in the cool of the night. The wine was processed without crushing the berries. Juice is then fermented in stainless steel tanks with cultured yeast.

Established in 1858 by English immigrant Edward Tyrrell, Tyrrell's Wines is one of Australia's preeminent family owned wineries with vineyards extending from Hunter Valley to the Limestone Coast (SA) and Heathcote (VIC). Headed up by fourth generation family member Bruce Tyrrell, it is home to some of Australia's most awarded wines. Since 1971, Tyrrell's has been awarded over 5,000 trophies and medals and in 2010 was named "Winery of the Year" by James Halliday's Australian Wine Companion. With the fifth generation involved in the business, Tyrrell's will continue to remain family owned with the simple philosophy of producing high quality wine.
