

## ZACHARIAS CHARDONNAY

100% Chardonnay. Very bright and fresh, showing rounded melon, yellow apple and verbena notes backed by a dried pineapple edge on the finish.

From the Zacharias family's own vineyards in the Selkia Leontiou location, 380 meters above sea level, in the Municipality of Nemea Valley, Corinth, Peloponnese. The first Zacharias vineyards were planted in 1962, around the village of Leontio, where wine has been produced for centuries. They are mainly on slopes, and today cover about 100 acres of land. The winery combines harmonically traditional elements, and state of the art technology. Aged 5 months in French oak.

The history of both the family's winery and vineyards dates back many years. Zacharias Vineyards is the largest private winery of its region and carries a rich historical past. One of the oldest and most historic wineries in Nemea, it has been operating since 1960. It is now one of the major wineries of the region as well as one of the fastest growing companies in the wine industry. The heart of Nemea vineyards, located just over a mile outside the city of Nemea, on the provincial road, is facing the hill where the acropolis of ancient Fliounda used to dominate. In ancient times, the area gave its name to the famous *fliassios oenos*, or wine from Fliassia country.
