

CHÂTEAU CONFIDENCE DE MARGAUX MARGAUX



Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Generous aromas of crushed blackberry, cassis and raspberry, salty minerality, hints of chocolate, violet and a subtle toasted note. Fruity and well-balanced, it has a nice acid frame and interesting minerality. Flavors of blackberry, cassis and slight notes of raspberry with hints of redcurrant, chocolate, vanilla/oak and subtle touches of sweet spices. The tannins are very slightly dry and a bit tight. Warm, long finish. The epitome of the expression of elegance in Margaux.

From a 6.2 acre vineyard in Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France. A mythical triangle of vines surrounded by Château Palmer, Rauzan Segla and Cantenac Brown, praised as the finest terroir one could hope for in the appellation. Rumor has it these vineyards will not stand on their own for long. Many believe these amazing vines will be absorbed into the Grand Crus. Plots of deep gravels. The quick-draining soils of the terroir are perfect for vines causing them to reach down deep to find water, gaining strength. Aged 20 months in oak barrels (40% new).

This beautiful Château is helmed by the brilliance of Dominique Befve, previous director of the iconic Château Lafite. He labored 10 years to reshape the vineyards of Château Lafite Rothschild, L'Evangile, and Rieussec. Seeking a new challenge, he then managed the direction of the second growth Chateau Lascombes in Margaux. His employers here were so grateful for his dedicated labor, that they now lend their winery and vinification equipment to his own winemaking endeavors.
