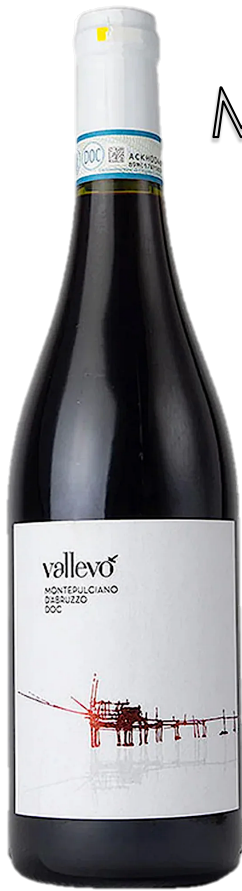


VALLEVÒ MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO



100% Montepulciano. Aromas and flavors of black plum, black cherry, herbs and black olives surround a wonderful meaty texture, with enough chewiness to make the wine stand up to food. This is the ideal 'spaghetti red,' at a price that will bring a smile to your face every time you open a bottle.

From the Montepulciano D'Abruzzo DOC in Abruzzo, Italy. The vineyard is 150m in altitude, southerly facing, with clay soil. The vines were planted in 1996. 10 days maceration on the skins, controlled low temperature fermentation in stainless steel with selected yeasts. Aged 12 months in stainless-steel. Fined and filtered, no cold stabilization.

Vallevo is a small co-operative winery in the Abruzzo region, near Chieti. Helmed by Gianni Pasquale, the wines of Vallevo are exactly right for everyday – flavorful, honest, well-made, and at a perfect price.
