

CHÂTEAU HAUT QUEYRAN MÉDOC CRU BOURGEOIS



Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Inky deep ruby color, with tones of purple throughout. Bright, lively tones of fresh blackcurrants, ripe black cherries, juicy strawberries, vanilla bean, toast and violets leap from the glass. On the palate, round, ripe tannins are buttressed by juicy acidity and dense flavors of fresh red and black plums, cracked cedar, fresh earth and graphite. This is the perfect weeknight Bordeaux, delivering smooth, precise flavors at a fantastic price.

The vineyard is made up of 30 acres of vines in the southern part of the Médoc, on the edge of St Estèphe on clay-limestone soil. It is the perfect expression of its terroir. Vinification is done in stainless steel vats and aging in concrete vats.

Staves give this wine its delicately woody notes.

In 1964, the Demarchi family acquired Château Haut Queyran, formerly Domaine de Haut Brion. Since 2001, the reins of the Château have been held by the Demarchi children, Eric and Patricia, who perpetuate the family tradition: the most total respect for the terroir.
