


CHÂTEAU LA ROSE BOIS MONTET CÔTES DE BORDEAUX



Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Juicy black cherry, plum and red currant, underpinned by earthy notes of cedar and a slight mineral edge. Medium-bodied with smooth, well-integrated tannins and fresh acidity. Lingering red fruit flavors and a touch of spice on the finish. Accessible and fruit-forward, it has pure charm and a jovial spirit. Organic.

The vineyards are located in Yvrac, in the Côtes de Bordeaux appellation area, Bordeaux, France. The soil is sandy clay and clay-limestone hillsides, a terroir well-suited for Merlot which thrives in these conditions. The vines are approximately 50-years-old. The grapes are fermented in stainless steel tanks. Aged in French oak barrels.

Vignoble Pestoury is a five-generation, family-owned winery located in Yvrac, near Bordeaux city, known for producing authentic, value-driven wines with a strong commitment to sustainable and organic farming practices. The history of Vignoble Pestoury dates back to 1892, when the great-grandmother of current owner Bertrand Pestoury first initiated the cultivation of vines as part of a diversified farm with livestock and fruit trees.

The family gradually focused more on viticulture over the generations. Bertrand Pestoury, an oenologist, and his wife Isabelle settled in 1997 with their first acquisition, Château Les Moulineaux, becoming the first generation to devote themselves fully to winemaking. Today, the adventure is a family affair, with their eldest daughter, Marie, having recently joined the estate. The estate spans approximately 94 acres across four different properties, all within the Côtes de Bordeaux appellation area. They combine traditional know-how with modern, environmentally conscious techniques.
